ISAAC COUNCILLORS OUT & ABOUT

The Isaac Regional Councillors have commenced a tour of their vast region of 60,000m². Councillors will travel the region to familiarize themselves with the infrastructure for which they are responsible and meet staff and the community. According to Mayor Cedric Marshall the tour is vital.

“Council has recognized that there are a number of unique communities within the region. Isaac Regional communities that have their own problems, history and aspirations. Likewise, Council currently provides different services to meet the needs of these communities. We as a group need to begin the process of understanding these communities and the level of service we currently provide” Cr. Marshall said.

Council has resolved to split the tour into three parts. Council undertook Stage 1 on Monday 12th May with visits to Glenden, Nebo and the coastal communities of Carmila and St Lawrence.

Stage 2 will be undertaken on 26th May which will cover the towns of Dysart, Middlemount and Clermont with a meet and greet planned at Clermont that night.

“The sheer size of the Shire has dictated that we split the tour given the difficulty we have getting all Councillors together. We intend to get around the rural area in Stage 3 of the program sometime in Winter. I would encourage members of the public to avail themselves of the opportunity to meet with their elected representatives so that their concerns are understood by Council”
