Nebo Showgrounds is one of Isaac Regional Council's most utilised recreational facilities.

It has an estimated local economic return of \$1.2 million.

The location of the showgrounds makes it accessible to visitors from the broader Mackay, Isaac, and Whitsunday areas. There is potential for increased growth in existing activities as well as the attraction of a number of other activities.
