WASTE AMNESTY DAY CONSIDERATION

Director Water and Waste provided an update to the Committee on the General Business Item raised at the April Water and Waste Standing Committee Meeting highlighting a few matters that need to be addressed to move forward with amnesty day. A presentation to council would be required outlining how the strategy fits into the overall management of waste to the community, how community disposes of waste and how the cost of the amnesty to council would be managed.

If the amnesty days are incorporated into the Waste Management Strategy, then lead time would be required to ensure it is completed in the most effective way including a communication plan regarding the implementation of the amnesty (do's and don'ts).

Cr Austen noted that the Committee needs to keep in mind the increase of illegal dumping which has escalated since increase in waste charge and the continuation of amnesty days could potentially reduce illegal dumping as well as save cost on council clean up.

Cr West – need a strategy of what council is trying to achieve and if it is to reduce illegal dumping then we need to focus on this

A discussion paper to be brought to a briefing day in the future to discuss the amnesty day and where it fits in as well as what will be included in the strategy

Review of the Waste Management Strategy with the inclusion of Amnesty Day consideration to be presented at the Strategic Planning Day in July 2022.

WATER PRESSURE AT TED ROLFE OVAL MORANBAH

Update provided to the Committee on General Business item raised at the April Water and Waste Standing Committee Meeting regarding water pressure at the Ted Rolfe Oval in Moranbah.

Manager Operations and Maintenance updated the Committee on discussions held between Water and Waste and Parks and Recreation noting that this is a joint issue between the two directorates and not a Water and Waste issue solely.

Manager Operations and Maintenance is working with Acting Manager Parks and Recreation to identify actions for each party to follow up on. Key dates have been set for actions items and will reconvene to look at the issues in July following adoption of the budget to understand what funds are available to address the issue.

Manager Operations and Maintenance is comfortable the pressure being sent is correct however tweaking of the irrigation systems to adequately supply enough water is one of the issues that has been highlighted.

Moving forward Manager Operations and Maintenance and Acting Manager Parks and Recreation will be working closely together on the whole Moranbah Network.

Cr West raised concerns that money has been spent on irrigation this financial year however we are unable to irrigate the Ted Rolfe Oval.
