Isaac Regional Council has a restriction on the number of dogs a resident can have in their home.

EXCESS

NUMBERS

Residents are allowed two dogs over the age of three months on an allotment in a designated town area, or one dog per multi-residential premise.

Under the *Local Laws No. 2 (Animal Management)* 2011, it states Council may, by subordinate local law, prohibit the keeping of animals in prescribed circumstances.

Legislation also outlines these restrictions with no provisions for applying to keep more than the allowable number of dogs or cats per allotment or multi-residential premise.

Isaac Regional Council understands that other Councils allow residents to apply for permits allowing more than two dogs per premise, however as the Isaac region does not have these provisions under their current Local Laws, Council is unable to give authority for the keeping of excess animals.
