

## ANNEXURE “A” – Additional Conditions

1. This permit is issued subject to livestock on this permit/application being in satisfactory condition to travel a minimum of 10 kilometers per day (allowing for young stock) and that all necessary animal husbandry requirements of these livestock are attended to by the owner or his/their representative.
2. In the event of any livestock that have to be rescued or put down, it is the responsibility of the owners or their representative to rescue, and if destroyed, dispose of same properly (not left on stock routes or reserves) at their own expense.
3. The owners or their representatives must give a minimum of 48 hours' notice to the occupiers of stock camping and watering reserves that have permits to occupy over such reserves, and that they are using to travel stock through.
4. The owners or their representatives must notify the Local Police that they will be droving stock along road reserves in their area.
5. The owners must supply traffic Controllers, at their cost, to control traffic where necessary.
6. Stock must be provided with water every night if they are not camped at an official Stock Route watering facility at the owner's expense.
7. This permit is issued subject to the applicant also being in possession and provision to Council of a copy of a current Main Roads Corridor Stock Travel Permit and the relevant conditions applicable.
8. If at any time the pumping capacity of any of the Stock Watering Facilities along the authorised stock travel route is insufficient to supply enough water to cater for the number of stock then it is the owner or their representative's responsibility to replenish the water supply at their own expense.
9. All stock is to be contained inside fenced areas before sunset daily and cannot be back on the stock route network before sunrise each morning.
