ISAAC REGIONAL COUNCIL ADOPTION OF: INTERIM LOCAL GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN AND ADOPTED INFRASTRUCTURE CHARGES RESOLUTION (NO. 4) 2026

Notice is given in accordance with the *Planning Act 2016* that, on 22 July 2026, Isaac Regional Council adopted Isaac Regional Planning Scheme 2021, version 1.2, inclusive of an Interim Local Government Infrastructure Plan, and the Adopted Infrastructure Charges Resolution (No. 4) 2026.

The Isaac Regional Planning Scheme 2021, version 1.2, inclusive of the Interim Local Government Infrastructure Plan, and the Adopted Infrastructure Charges Resolution (No. 4) 2026 shall have force and effect from the 1 September 2026. Their purpose and general effect are to:

- Integrate infrastructure planning with land use planning identified in the planning scheme.
- Provide transparency regarding Council's intentions for the provision of trunk infrastructure.
- Enable Council to estimate the cost of infrastructure provision to assist its long-term financial planning.
- Ensure trunk infrastructure is planned and provided in an efficient and orderly manner
- Provide a basis for the imposition of conditions about infrastructure on development approvals.

The Isaac Regional Planning Scheme 2021, version 1.2, that includes the Local Government Infrastructure Plan, and the Adopted Infrastructure Charges Resolution (No. 4) 2026 applies to the Isaac Regional Council local government area except where an area identified in the Galilee Basin State Development Area Development Scheme 2014, has force and effect.

The Isaac Regional Planning Scheme 2021, version 1.2 shall supersede the Isaac Regional Planning Scheme 2021, version 1.1.

Charges Resolution (No. 4) 2026 shall supersede Charges Resolution (No. 3) 2021.
