7. GENERAL BUSINESS

7.1 St Francis Drive Moranbah Reseal

Cr West asked what is being done about recent reseal on St Francis Drive, Moranbah that is lifting.

Response: The Director Engineering and Infrastructure advised that this section will be reviewed in next year's maintenance program, possibly a different method will be used in future maintenance programs for this section of road.

7.2 Generic Communications re Road Maintenance

Cr Moffat asked if Council could put out generic communications regarding road maintenance during weather events. Example is when we have inclement weather and there are increasing potholes on the roads.

Could we put up a generic statement advising community that Council are experiencing an increased level of road damage on the regions roads due to inclement weather and advise that our teams are currently are inspecting and doing repairs as quickly as possible and we ask community to drive to current conditions.

Is there anything that Council can do to have this investigated by Queensland Police and TMR.
