## LEICHHARDT ROOM

CAPACITY: 430

This room, named in honour of Ludwig Leichhardt, the first European explorer to visit the Peak Downs region in 1845, is a testament to history and modern elegance.

It can accommodate up to 430 people in a theatre-style setting, complete with a stage perfect for captivating performances and impactful presentations.

Adding to its charm is the original dance floor from 1974 when the Moranbah Community Centre was first built, ideal for lively parties, galas, and celebrations.

The customisable lighting allows you to set the perfect ambiance for any event, making this space truly versatile and inspiring.



## LEICHHARDT FOYER

The Leichhardt Foyer, named after the first European explorer Ludwig Leichhardt, features a sleek, modern design with a polished countertop and stylish bar stools.


## CHAPEL



# CELEBRATING DECADES OF COMMUNITY, CULTURE AND HISTORY

The Moranbah Community Centre, was built by Belyando Shire Council, Utah Development Company and the Combined Churches and was officially opened on Thursday 29 November 1973, by the then Governor of Queensland, His Excellency Air Marshal Sir Colin Hannah.

Initially serving as a meeting place and ecumenical church, the building symbolised a new era in community living and quickly became a popular venue for the town's 3,100 residents to gather for services and activities.

The first wedding took place in 1974, with many more to follow as young couples and families flocked to Moranbah.

Over the years, the Centre's stages have hosted theatre productions from both local and touring companies, as well as numerous theatre restaurants. Big names in entertainment, such as Ron Rico, the Delltones, the 4 Kinsmen, and

even the Wiggles, have performed there, while the resident grand piano became the centrepiece of many musical events.

High-ranking politicians have also visited, including Prime Ministers Bob Hawke, Paul Keating and Julia Gillard, Premier Anna Bligh, and Governor-General Dame Quentin Bryce and Governor-General Paul de Jersey.

The rooms have been home to local clubs and group AGMs, general meetings, music and dance exams, school art shows, and graduations.

Government conferences and elections were held here, and the annual Home Show would spill out onto the neighbouring Ted Rolfe Oval.

Doctors conducted medicals, and Weight Watchers ran slimming programs in the rooms beneath the main stage. Meanwhile, inside the halls, mine functions and union meetings hosted hundreds

of workers, the kitchen served countless meals, and drinks flowed across the bar. A true highlight of the Centre has always been the spring floor in the main hall.

Still in use today, it has seen countless Mayoral Balls, Debutante Balls, and has helped create many beautiful memories throughout the Centre's life. Award ceremonies, movie nights, funerals, jazz sessions, line dancing, dance lessons, career expos, and discos — there's not much the Centre hasn't hosted since the 1970s. In 1988, significant upgrades and extensions were made to meet the needs of a growing population.

Then, in 2024, with Isaac Region communities more engaged than ever, it was decided that the Centre should reflect this progress. After months of major refurbishment, the Centre began a new, modern chapter on 22 March 2025, proudly rebranded as the Isaac Events Centre.
