WHAT TO PUT IN THE RED-LID BIN:

- General household waste
- Non-recyclable plastic
- Green waste

BIN DAY REMINDERS:

- Kerb bins by 6am
- Keep 1m gap between bins
- Don't overfill and close lids
- Bins must be under 75kg
- Collections continue on holidays



WHAT TO PUT IN THE YELLOW-LID BIN:

- Cardboard boxes crushed and torn to prevent jamming
- Rigid plastic containers, milk, juice, soft drink and detergent bottles
- Glass bottles and jars
- Newspapers, magazines, paper and telephone books
- Aerosol, aluminium and steel cans
